## THE BUZZFREE MISSION IS...

To encourage and reward healthy choices made by high school students in our community. We seek to prevent and reduce underage drinking, driving under the influence and use of other drugs among youth in our community.

## THE EVENT

The BuzzFree PROMises Dress & Tuxedo Giveaway helps local teens obtain prom attire but includes educational components and a drug-free pledge not usually found in other dress giveaway programs. In exchange for their pledge, students participate in a variety of workshops and are rewarded with a prom gown, tux or suit. Students that participate in the program must be enrolled in 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade, hold an academic average of at least a “C”, and have good record of attendance and citizenship.

The Council on Alcohol & Drug Abuse facilitates the collaborative BuzzFree PROMises Dress & Tux Giveaway, serving as the fiscal and primary programmatic agent.
